- 3. Painted rocks are located in very visible locations and in one area per location.
- 4. Rocks are not hidden on private residences, inside businesses, or in grassy areas.
- 5. Large nesting Dragon Eggs are protected. Please do not disturb them.
- 6. Visit <u>www.registeryourrock.org</u> with a photo/location of where you find your rock or where you go with it.
- 7. The clues below are to guide you towards a specific location. Enjoy!

<u>Clues</u>

- 1. Come to this special place. It's where you can meditate. Round and round you go. Let your imagination flow.
- 2. The red boat you never want to see but celebrate its arrival if you are adrift at sea. You will find this on Link. If you drive too fast you may end up in the clink.
- 3. If a sailor wants to buy their house by the sea they just need to stop by this waterman's reality.
- 4. To find this treasure paws to think about the love our fur babies get from the loving care given by this vet.
- 5. A place that handles nautical repairs for sailors which is found along this waterway. They consider the craftmen a treasure if they can set sail without delay.
- 6. This little piggy went to market and squealed with delight at all the options in sight.
- 7. Where the land and the water meet, join the dragons and have a seat. Look all around so your treasures can be found. (3 locations)
- 8. Where gifts from the land and sea abound. Pies made by the hands of a town treasure are also found.
- 9. Up, down, curly, or straight. To find this treasure remember the limit is 55, so don't be late.
- 10. CDs generate interest here but not for the music lover's ear.
- 11. Run, swing or slide to collect your prize.
- 12. Where musicians sing, strum, synthesize and drum. It's where two for one pies come from.
- 13. A little sand and maybe some waves. If you find a rock here it will make your day.
- 14. Nautical visitors pull in for a day or two. They visit here to enjoy a morning chat, a muffin, and a nice hot brew.
- 15. Visitors come here by land and sea. They may find a treasure while they get information and experience a bit of history.
- 16. Enjoy the view and relax in the sun. Finding a rock here adds to the fun.
